shops, restaurants, and art galleries. Finish your day with a visit to the East Side Gallery, a section of the Berlin Wall that has been covered in vibrant street art.



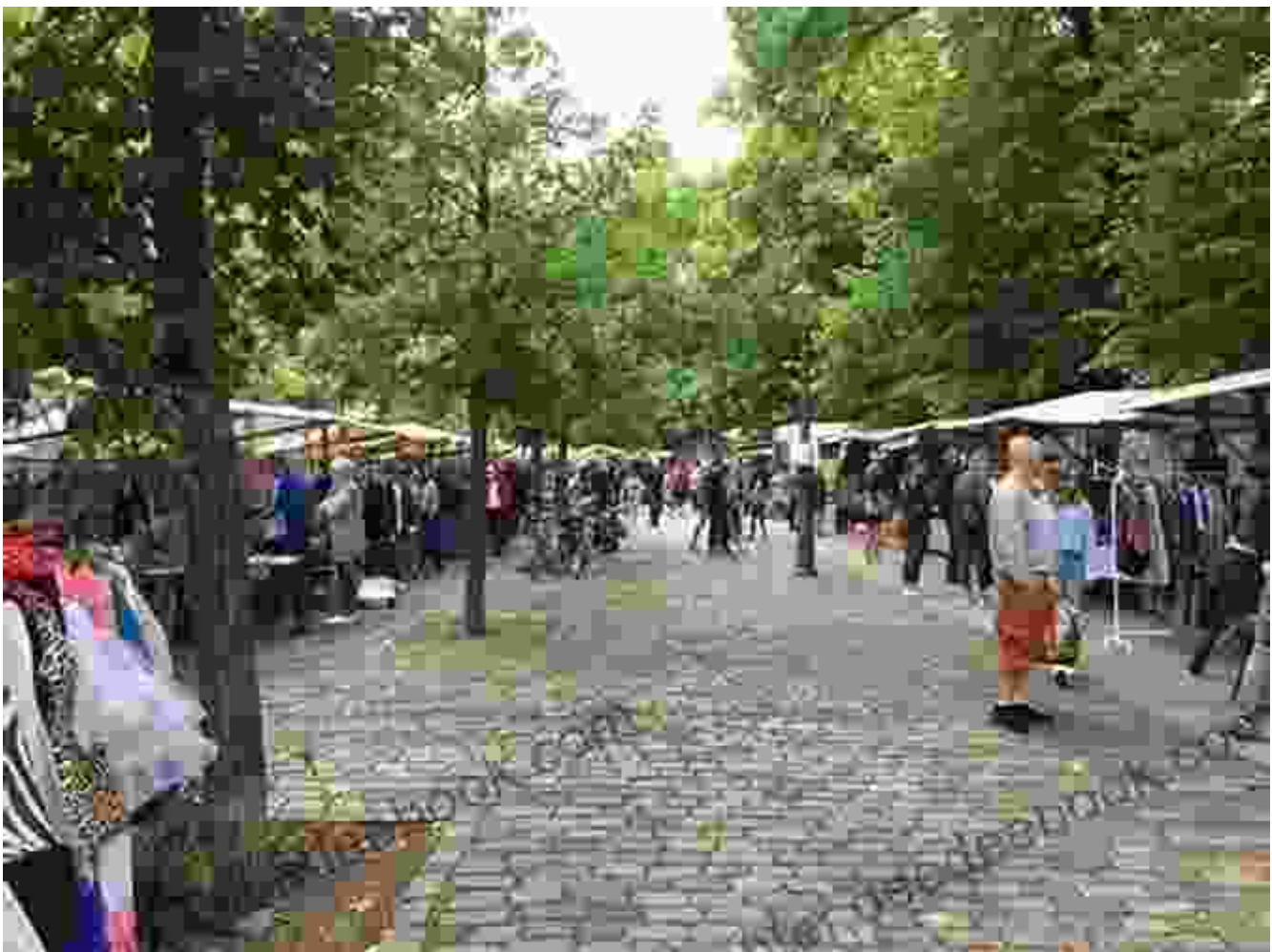

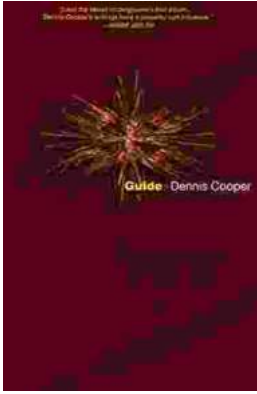
