Gameplay

Galactic Grid Games 13 is played on a 9x9 grid of squares. Each square contains a number, which can be a single digit, a two-digit number, or a three-digit number. 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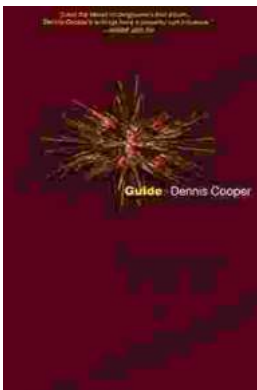
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
