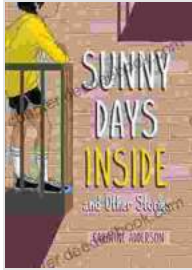

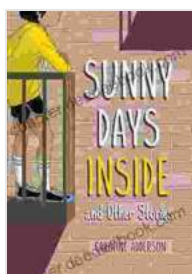
The Author

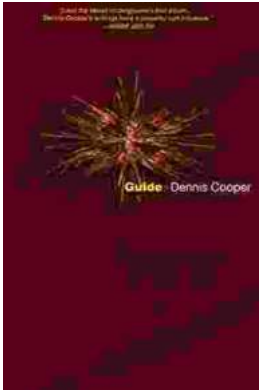
